







Typical symptoms include: fever, malaise; headache; runny nose; sneezing; reduced sense of smell; metallic taste in the mouth; chills; and cough.











To minimise the transmission of seasonal influenza the following non-pharmaceutical measures can be applied:



Avoid close contact with sick individuals, practice proper hygiene including frequent hand washing, avoid touching the mouth, eyes, and nose, and covering coughs and sneezes (preferably into your elbow or a tissue, which should be promptly disposed of away from others).

Also, ensure proper ventilation in classrooms and offices.
